**Vachan = Spoke word of Lord Swaminarayan**

**Amrut= nectar**

**Satsangijeevan**

**Satsangi = devotee of God**

**Jeevan = way of life**

**Brahm**

**Soul that has escaped cycle of birth and death**

**Parbrahm**

**Par= beyond**

**Parbrahm = almighty God Supreme**



# Shree Swaminarayan Yuvak Mandal

**SWAMINARAYAN SAMPRADAY** teaches one, the difference between **SATSANG** and **KUSANG** in the **SHIKSHAPATRI**. If you have **SHRADHA** in this, then you can become a **BHAKTA** by associating with **SATSANGIS** and reading **VACHNAMRUT**, **SATSANGIJEEVAN** and etc. This will lead one to become a **BRAHM** and hence serve **PARBRAHM** .
